Ragazzi is a place to enjoy handmade pasta and handmade wine.




Our Executive Chef Scott McComas-Williams says that each of the hundred or so pasta shapes that the Italians use has its own specific purpose. That each one will work with a particular sauce better than any other shape. Not only that, but each shape is a product of the culture of its place of origin. Places lucky enough to inherit tomatoes from South America created tubular shapes to catch the bright red sauce; wealthier towns used eggs in their recipe because they could.

It got us thinking about Italian wine and how out of all the multitudes of different landscapes that dot the country, some were simply the absolute best pairing for one of the hundreds of native Italian grape varieties. Nebbiolo and Barolo, Brunello and Montalcino. Fiano and Avellino. And also how exciting the whole ridiculous complexity of Italian wine really is, and how fun.

Much like the kitchen, if the winemakers of Italy want to get the very best out of these magical pairings, they need to let the grapes and the places work together with minimal interference and with the utmost respect to the culture and traditions of their region. Our way of thinking is they already have the best ingredients, so the less that they do in the winery the better. That's why we've chosen the wines that we have. They are traditional, delicious and handmade.

We've broken the wine list into Northern, Central and Southern Italian sections. In each, we've also included a selection of similarly styled international wines.

NV Adami 'Bosco di Gica' – Prosecco Valdobbiadene Superiore - Piedmont <i>Versatile and well balanced. Delicate jasmine flower on the nose is joined by apple and peach. Dry and Fresh prosecco, crisp and lemon-like zest. Pure class in a glass.</i>	21
NV Paltrinieri, 'Radice' – Lambrusco di Sorbarà – Emilia Romagna <i>A Ragazzi favourite, this exquisite bubbly rosato is everything you need to start off a great meal. Light strawberries and wild raspberry aromas, super fine bubble with a nice kick of freshness on the finish.</i>	19
NV Ferrari 'Maximum' Blanc de Blanc – Chardonnay – Trentino <i>Since 1902 Ferrari (not the car!) Has been a name synonymous with premium Italian sparkling. Giulio Ferrari was one of the first Italians to produce a sparkling wine in the champagne / traditional method, whilst also being the first to recognise the potential of Trentino for producing high quality wines. The wine is 100% chardonnay from the slopes of the Dolomites, aged for a hefty 30 months on lees (longer than many Champagnes) before being released. The nose presents chardonnay's classic character of granny smith apple and lemon zest, complemented by toasted brioche, biscuit and roasted hazelnut. A wine of fantastic intensity and length.</i>	34

2021 Masseria Frattasi 'Donnalaura' Falanghina del Sannio – Falanghina – Campania <i>A one-of-a-kind Falanghina from the volcanic terroir of Campania. Ingeniously, the grapes are harvested late to allow for much greater flavour development. This gives the wine lovely weight and texture, supported by notes of fresh nectarine, Apricot del Vesuvio and orange blossom. An excellent line of acidity keeps this drop in balance.</i>	19 53
2022 Frederik Stevenson Bianco – Vermentino, Inzolia, Pecorino – Adelaide Hill's 48 <i>A mediterranean-inspired white from the Barossa Avantgarde Steve Crawford AKA Frederik Stevenson. Crisp, saline and zesty, with Lemon rind, saltbush and granny smith apple. This is made for food.</i>	- 17
2020 Sadivino – Chardonnay – Emilia-Romagna 59 <i>A weighted, textural Chardonnay from Italy's gastronomic heartland. Ripe yellow peach, nectarine and grapefruit accompany a creamy, toasty palate. Refreshing acidity keeps the wine taut, balancing it's richness.</i>	21
2022 Foradori 'Fontanasanta' - Manzoni Bianco – Trentino <i>Elisabetta Foradori is the woman that put Trentino on the map, a champion of the regions native grapes. Manzoni bianco is a local hybrid of Riesling and Pinot Bianco, combine Riesling's crispness and aromatics with the body and creaminess of Pinot Bianco. A wine of depth and complexity, offering concentrated aromas of fresh cut green apple, Meyer lemon, orange blossom. The palate is weighted and yet oh so refreshing.</i>	23 64
2021 La Tunella 'Biancosesto' - Friulano, Ribolla Gialla – Friuli-Venezia Giulia <i>Hailing from the established Friuli estate La Tunella, comes 'Biancosesto', a blend of native Friulano and Ribolla Gialla. At the foundation of La Tunella is the brotherly bond of Massimo and Marco Zorzettig, third generation farmers in Friuli who bring with them expertise that has been passed down through the decades. The wine presents a delicate nose of white peach, acacia and orange blossom, veiling a palate of great freshness. Gooseberry, lemon granita and flint in the mouth followed by a herbal finish.</i>	25 70

2020 Marabino 'Muscatedda' – Moscato di Noto – Sicily <i>A pristine, glassy orange from the sun baked vineyards of Noto, Sicilia. Yellow apple, honeysuckle, ginger and ripe peaches combine with a silky palate. An excellent entry into the world of orange wine.</i>	21 59
2018 Le Due Terre 'Sacrissassi Bianco' - Friulano, Ribolla Gialla - Fruili-Venezia Giulia <i>Rich and bold notes of apple, peach and honey. Deep yellow and slightly golden. Two weeks on skins and two years on oak provide gorgeous texture and an elegant, well rounded palate.</i>	28 79

2022 Caruso & Minini ‘Frappo’ – *Frappato* – Sicily

Perfect summer wine. The nose sings with watermelon, pink grapefruit and fresh strawberry. An undercurrent of minerality on the palate with refreshing acidity.

2022 Praesidium Cerasuolo d’Abruzzo – *Montepulciano* – Abruzzo

Abruzzo, well-known for producing rich wines from Montepulciano, is secretly producing some of the best Rosato’s in Italy. A deep cherry colour with a beautiful bouquet of smoked Morena cherries, crushed rocks and mediterranean underbrush. Palate is full-bodied, yet still refreshing and absolutely delicious.

2022 Unico Zelo ‘Fresh A.F’ – Nero d’Avola, Zibbibo – Riverlands

Juicy, succulent and refreshing. A heady nose of blackberry tart, violet and bramble coupled with a moreish palate and velvety tannins. So smashable it’s not funny.

2021 Azienda Agricole Brangero Barbera d’Alba – *Barbera* – Piedmont

A deep, brooding Barbera that shows much generosity on both the nose and palate. Heady aromas of black plums, bramble, vanilla and cedar. A silky mouthfeel with very fine, tingly tannins provide a framework for a fantastic core of stewed black cherry and cassis.

2022 Institut Agricole Regional “Grains Rouges” – *Gamay, Gamaret* – Vallee d’Aosta

The institute of Agriculture was founded in 1952, responsible for promoting the study and professional training of students focussing primarily on biodynamic wine. Grapes are picked from a south-facing sunny vineyard. A luscious violet colour in the glass, fresh fruit with a subtle hint of spice, refreshing, medium body.

2021 Ciacci Piccolomini ‘Ateo’ – *Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot* – Montalcino, Tuscany

A delicious, full bodied wine expressing lovely mulberry and cassis on the nose. The palate shows Merlot’s plummy and juicy character combined with the broad shoulders of Cabernet. Let’s face it, it’s what we all want with our ragú.

2020 Cala di Seta ‘Desea’ - *Carignano* - Sardinia

A lovely mid-weight, juicy wine from the sandy slopes of Sulcis, Sardinia. Carignan, brought over from Spain during Spanish occupation, has found its second home here in Sardegna, producing plush wines with plenty of character. The nose brims with violet, black plum, cherry, mulberry jam. The palate is soft and round. Fantastic pasta wine.

2018 Matteo Correggia ‘Roche d’Ampsej’ Roero Riserva - *Nebbiolo* - Roero, Piedmont

Before his tragic passing in 2001, Matteo Correggia has already proved that his wines could go toe to toe with the greats of Piemonte. Upon his passing, his wife Ornella Correggia immediately took up the mantel and runs the company to this day. This is a wine of fantastic depth and complexity. A kaleidoscope of macerated cherries, cinnamon, orange peel, cedar and dried flowers will all develop in the glass over time.

2018 Colleoni Rosso di Montalcino – *Sangiovese* – Montalcino, Tuscany

A classic wine from a classic estate. On an evening stroll in 90s, Marino Colleoni and his wife Luisa discovered an abandoned vineyard in the northern reaches of Montalcino. Flash-forward to today and Marino is one of the most progressive and interesting producers of Brunello di Montalcino, and one of the only to do it organically. Amaro, orange zest and red cherry on the nose with a mineral, earthy palette combining detail, texture and finesse.

NV Colomba Bianca ‘Legadi’ Liquoroso – *Zibbibo* – Sicily


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A little sweet number from the sun baked hills of Alcamo, Sicily. Lusciously sweet with a bouquet of figs, peaches in syrup, elderflower, orange blossom and a touch of cinnamon.

2016 Lillypilly Wines ‘Noble Harvest’ – Semillion, Sauvignon Blanc, Vermentino – Leeton

The Riverina doing what it does best, Botrytised dessert wines. Lillypilly have been a champion of the style for over 40 years and show no signs of slowing down. Gorgeous aromas of marmalade, dried apricot, dried chamomile and red apple jam. The palate showcases an excellent balance of sugar and acidity.

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




